## Who is eligible?

All full-time, matriculated undergraduate, graduate, and law students are automatically charged for the Student Health Insurance Plan. Students should proactively enroll through MySlice to obtain an ID card. Students have the opportunity to waive the Student Health Insurance Plan by providing proof of qualifying coverage through MySlice.

Fall deadline: Monday, Sept. 15, 2025\*  
Spring deadline: Monday, Feb. 2, 2026\*

As a Syracuse University student enrolled in the Student Health Insurance Plan, you have access to Aetna's Teladoc services. Teladoc is a way to be treated for non-severe medical issues without having to physically visit a provider's office. Through Teladoc, you can be treated for all of the following:

- General Medical (24/7 care by web, phone or mobile app): Cold & flu, allergies, bronchitis, sinus infection, rash, sore throat, skin problems, and respiratory infections.
- Behavioral Health (video appointments available 7am-9pm seven days a week): Support for anxiety, eating disorders, depression, and family issues.
- Dermatology (log into your Teladoc account to upload images to get started): treatment for complex issues such as psoriasis, eczema, and acne.
