Frequently Asked Questions

What is my enrollment deadline? Fall: September 30, 2023 Spring: February 15, 2024

Will I be notified if you haven't received my Waiver? SUNY ESF student health insurance plan is a voluntary enrollment plan for domestic students, no waiver is required

Where do I enroll? Domestic students can enroll by visiting https://www.haylor.com/suny-esf

Do I have to waive every semester or just once a year? This is a voluntary enrollment plan for domestic students, no waivers are required. Domestic students are only billed if they enroll. Enrollments are done annually in the fall, unless you're a new spring student

How do I get an Insurance ID Card? Download a copy of your insurance card by visiting https://www.haylor.com/suny-esf & then select Download ID

How do I find a Doctor that accepts my student health insurance? You can view doctors that accept your insurance by visiting https://www.haylor.com/suny-esf & then select Find A Doctor

How do I enroll my spouse or child in the health coverage? Spouse & Child(ren) are not eligible for enrollment in this program

How do I find what is covered under my student health insurance? You can view entire health plan benefits by visiting https://www.haylor.com/suny-esf & then select Plan Highlights or Coverage Detail

I lost my insurance coverage, how do I enroll in the student health insurance plan? Please contact student@haylor.com with a copy of your curent insurance carrier's termination letter to begin the enrollment process. Once enrollment is finalized, payment will be required to Haylor, Freyer & Coon Inc

Does this plan contain dental coverage? No, dental coverage is only available for pediatric members (under age of 19)

How do I cancel the student health insurance? Mid-year terminations are not accepted
